Take I64 East

Take Exit 123 toward New Albany E (0.3 mi);

Merge onto W 5th St (436 ft);

Turn left at W Market St (0.5 mi);

Turn left at E 3rd St (443 ft); Parking in the right in church lot.

From Indianapolis

Take I65 South;

Take Exit 6b, I-265 W/IN-62 W/Lee H Hamilton Hwy via Exit 6b toward New Albany;

Merge onto I64 E/US-150 E via Exit 0 on the left toward New Albany, Louisville;

Take Exit 123 toward New Albany E (0.3 mi);

Merge onto W 5th St (436 ft);

Turn left at W Market St (0.5 mi);

Turn left at E 3rd St (443 ft); Parking in the right in church lot.

From Kentucky

Take I64 West; cross into Indiana and take the first exit, New Albany onto Elm Street;

Follow Elm Street to E 3rd Street and turn right;

Drive past Spring Street, past church, and parking lot is on the left.
